Thank you for considering representing your brewery at the Cascade Rail Foundation's (CRF) Third Ever Rails To Ales Brewfest in South Cle Elum, WA on July 10th, 2010 from 4- 10PM. This Brewfest is a major fundraiser for our organization each year. We have worked closely with Washington State Parks and Recreation since 1999 to develop and improve the portion of Iron Horse State Park at the South Cle Elum Railyard. CRF is a registered non-profit in the state of Washington. To find out more about our organization, visit www.milwelectric.org

As one of the participating brewers, we require that you send 1-2 representatives knowledgeable about your brews and process. Each brewer will be provided with a six foot table, ice, water pitcher, dump buckets, and a volunteer to assist with serving and taking scrip. **We ask that you DO NOT plan to leave the volunteers on their own for extended periods. We had several comments in our survey from the 2009 event with issues of brewers not being at the table and volunteers (understandably) not having information about the beers being poured.** Tables will be set up under tents we provide. If you have your own tent and would like to use it please contact us to make arrangements.

We will be having just one 5 oz. for pouring to maintain portion control. Brewers will not be allowed to fill larger glasses. **CRF souvenir glasses and brewery glasses may be purchased and used at the event but may NOT be filled directly. Guests may fill from their sample glasses if they so choose.**

Our insurance provider requires proof of liability insurance, **with Cascade Rail Foundation named as an additional insured**, from each participating brewery, please provide us with a copy to complete our files.

You or your distributor will need to provide your beer and a jockey box. Beer must arrive at the site already chilled OR delivered to the site at least 24 hours in advance and it will be kept chilled. **Set-up must be completed and vehicles moved off site by 3pm the day of the event.** You may bring any promotional merchandise you wish to sell or distribute free to guests from your table. You will also be provided with ten (10) food scrip per person, limit of two persons per brewer.

Once again there will be live music playing during the event. There will be 4-6 food vendors this year and they will be located more prominently. Washington State Parks and recreation will be providing the breathalyzer tent. A big hit each year!
